- Receives driving school permit

FBL has today received the official approval letter from the Land Transport Authority (LTA) to operate a driving school. This new business venture will complement the human resource business as potential recruiting companies from Japan require candidates to hold a driver's license. Hence, all the Fijian students enrolled into the Japanese Language School who do not have a license will undergo driving lessons with FBL at the expense of their sponsor employers from Japan.

In addition to this, FBL is looking to extend this service to its International students who wish to obtain a license in Fiji. Executive Chairman Mr Hiroshi Taniguchi said, "It is very expensive to obtain a license in Japan and we hope that this business venture will create an opportunity for our Japanese students to obtain a license in Fiji and convert this license to a Japanese license once they return. Having this driving school in-house allows us to directly schedule and plan our program to better suit our clients' needs."

We hope that this new business venture will allow us to fully maximise our potential revenue from existing students and provide a wider option for our potential clients from the various international markets. As a result of this, FBL has hired a licensed driving school instructor and purchased two driving school vehicles that will be used for this.
